EMILY SUN SHINE had speed from the start while hung four wide, gave up some ground on the turn, came on again between horses in deep stretch and proved best in a stiff drive. JOSEY AVENUE close up form the start, moved up along the inside, made the lead in upper stretch, matched strides to the wire and just missed. UNSEEN DANCER always within striking distance, angled three wide on the turn, advanced steadily but was too late. MUSICAL LARK had a mild late rally. DUNWOODY GIRL unhurried, swung out near the middle of the racetrack entering the stretch then passed tiring rivals while no threat. ALASAN was hustled up between horses to gain a slight lead before a quarter, edged clear on the turn then gradually weakened. MONDAY MORNING contested the lead along the inside until the turn then weakened. WHO'S HER DADDY flashed speed, stopped and returned bleeding from the nostrils.
