BLOOD DIAMONDS pressed the pace two wide from the start, responded when set down entering the stretch, made the lead before the eighth pole and drew clear under strong encouragement. LADY SYMPHONY never far back, loomed boldly along the rail entering the stretch, drew on even terms for the lead before the eighth pole then finished second best. CANDY TIGER had a mild late rally. SHELBY'S A PRO away alertly, set the pace into the stretch then weakened late. ULTIMATE BLISS vied for the lead for three eighths then weakened. LUCKY LIBBY was no threat. SHE'S GOT THE LOOT delayed the start while refusing to load then trailed.
