GENERAL LAFAYETTE taken in hand to trail early, remained well back while inside for six furlongs, altered course sharply outside, circled horses willingly through the stretch and drew clear under strong handling. CHIEF INSPECTOR prompted the pace two wide for a little over a half, made the lead, set the pace until mid stretch then could not handle the winner. BOBBIE'S DEVIL never far back, offered a bid four wide into the stretch then leveled off. BLIND BLUFF had speed from the start, moved up three wide on the second turn then failed to sustain his bid. COME UNDONE vied for the lead three wide from the start, loomed boldly on the second turn then came up empty. ACTIVE TRADER set the pace for a little over a half, had speed into the stretch then stopped. ELDOKTORI offered little.
