OUR CONCERTO battled for the lead into the turn, gave up some ground and swung wide entering the stretch, came on again under right handed urging to make the lead late and drew clear. TIME OUT TY had speed from the start, drew on even terms for the lead three wide on the turn, matched strides until deep stretch, could not handle the winner but gamely gained second. RADICCHIO set a pressured pace until deep stretch then weakened slightly. MAJESTY LANE passed tiring rivals while no threat. HOPE'S JET had brief speed. SKY TERRY failed to menace. GETTEM READY EDDIE offered little. THREE KNOCKS was through early.
