BEAU MEC dueled for the early lead, gained a clear lead at the quarter pole, remained safe through the lane under confident handling. FINAL RULE stalked the pace, finished willing and was clearly second best. CANDOSO never far back, had a mild bid, no threat. RAKEEN ORATORY dueled for the lead for a half, weakened in the stretch. TARA BULL well placed and saved ground, evenly. WHODATE PYRITE allowed to settle early, failed to respond when asked. MR. NATIVE was never a threat. CLIFF DIVIN raced between horses and tired. PERFECT CHAMP was never in contention. LIVINGSTONBELLE was outrun. BUCKEY SLEW was outrun. MR. RAVEN was through early.
