MONETARY REWARD stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch four wide with a quick move, prevailed after a long drive under strong handling. LAST EFFORT was well placed on the inside, split horses at the top of the stretch, finished willingly in a good effort. B MOORE BENTLEY unhurried early, swung wide in the upper stretch, finished well late and was gaining. SAY HAY BY WAY allowed to settle early, swung wide at the top of the stretch and closed a gap. WOOD BE SWEET dueled on the lead from inside down the backside, shook clear as the quarter pole, weakened slightly in the stretch. B K CONNECTION dueled three wide for a half, tired in the stretch. SUNDAY REWARD allowed to settle, failed to menace. MUMKIN was off slowly and was outrun. HAMBONE set a pressured pace for a half, came up empty in the stretch.
