C O RINGO chased the pacesetter while racing in the three path for a half, drifted wide entering the stretch, rallied out in the middle of the racetrack to make the lead late and won under a strong hand ride. CANOE IN A SLEW never far back, loomed boldly after splitting horses nearing the quarter pole then finished second best. FURKA PASS set the pace until deep stretch in the two path then was outfinished. THREEWISEMEN close up early, faded. MING DYNASTY offered a mild bid on the turn then came up empty. SADLER POWER widest of all into the turn, was through early. I. C. MET had brief speed.
