Footnotes

CHANGE PLEASE away alertly, dropped inside soon after the start, set a pressured pace the balance of the pace, dug in late under left handed urging and just lasted while drifting out in the final strides. DECORATE had speed from the start, rallied four wide through the stretch and just missed getting up in time. SKIM SCAM always within striking distance, moved up along the inside through the stretch, ran into a blind switch inside the sixteenth pole, came out bumping EARL'S GRAPE then checked when in tight between horses through the final yards. EARL'S GRAPE prompted the pace between horses until deep stretch, was bumped and forced out late causing his rider to check over DECORATE'S heels then faded. HIS NAME WAS RICO was no threat. HELLO FAME was no factor. TIMELY WONDER was always outrun. LARMON lacked speed and stopped after a half. The stewards posted the inquiry sign and the rider of EARL'S GRAP lodged a claim of foul against the riders of SKIM SCAM and DECORATE for interference in deep stretch. After reviewing the video tape replay, the stewards disqualified SKIM SCAM and placed him fourth.
