LOVE SURPRISES settled just off the leaders for five furlongs, angled out three wide, made the lead at the top of the stretch, dug in gamely late and prevailed under brisk handling. MUFASA CAT never far back, angled out five wide on the second turn, moved to the winner then just missed. TWOBITHUSTLER outrun early, offered a strong bid along the rail entering the stretch then leveled off. BELLEOFTHEVALLEY well placed along the inside, failed to offer a closing response. ANSWER MAN settled mid pack then failed to offer a closing response. LAST BAND away alertly, set a pressured pace for six furlongs then gradually gave way. RAINY DAY WILLIE was outrun. BADGE OF RED pressed the pace two wide for six furlongs then stopped. AUNTRUTHIE'SSECRET offered little.
