JOHN JOHN'S GIFT with the second flight in a stalking position, rallied three wide entering the second turn, made the lead near the five sixteenths pole, opened a clear advantage in mid stretch and held SANGORE safe under brisk handling. SANGORE settled mid pack, closed on the second turn behind the winner and finished willingly while second best. CHANDAS trailed for a half, moved up on the second turn out in the four path then finished evenly. SICKY NICKY chased the winner to that one's outside for a half, dropped along the rail, bid at the three eighths pole along the fence then weakened once in the stretch. DABOSSMAN failed to menace. AMENHOTEP offered a mild bid on the second turn then came up empty. SMAK DAB was through after a half. LEDGEHILL set the pace into the second turn then stopped.
