DREAMBOAT CHARLIE prompted the pace between horses while confidently handled, responded readily when roused entering the stretch, quickly made the lead and opened a clear advantage before the eighth pole then won going away. DIAMOND APPEAL allowed to settle, rallied three wide through the stretch and finished clear for second. VALIENTE CORAZON settled mid pack into the stretch then passed tiring rivals late. JAMBALAYA JO set a pressured pace along the rail into the stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner readily then weakened late. RAFFIE'S DELIGHT bore in at the star then failed to reach contention. HEAVENLY STRIPES was forced in and shut off at the start then never threatened. GIFTATNOON prompted the pace three wide into the turn then weakened. MONEY EYED BOY was outrun. THUNDER AND LIGHTS offered little.
