BEAU MEC was away alertly and quickly set the pace, was nicely rated on the front end, prevailed through a long drive under strong handling. ROYALDISH pressed the winner throughout, finished willingly in a good effort but could not get by the winner. SWOOPER well placed and saved ground, needed more late. MOUNT BREVETOR never far back, had a mild bid while no threat. LAZYLOU CARSON never far back, lacked a late response. BEHRLY JUMPIN well placed for three quarters, had no late kick. GRIDIRON KEY allowed to settle, failed to menace. GENERAL LAFAYETTE showed little. GULCH POINT was outrun.
