STAND OF HICKORY away alertly, set the pace while getting rapid fractions and won under a hand ride. DUTY CALLS bore in badly at the start bumping FATHER TIME and forcing that one into JEST A GENIUS, saved ground and finished clear for second. JEST A GENIUS was bumped and forced in at the start, was allowed to settle then had a mild late rally out in the four path. CASHIER READY hit the side of the gate at the start then passed tiring rivals late. YOUNG APOLLO chased a fast pace for a half then tired. ROYAL EXPRESS had brief speed. BAND PLAYER was outrun. FATHER TIME was bumped, forced into JEST A GENIUS at the start, had speed into the turn then started pulling up before the five sixteenths pole however crossed the wire, was lame when pulled up and vanned off.
