NEBO allowed to settle, passed tiring rivals, while no threat. GLIDE OVER PYRITE well placed, weakened in the stretch. RUSHING RAINBOW failed to menace. SOMERSET'S DANCER set the pace, then gave way in the stretch. ME BIG BOY had brief foot, then stopped. SEAN'S FOLLY was always outrun.
