GOVERNOR JEB never far back, rallied in the upper stretch four wide, drew clear late under right handed pressure. BLAZIN DAR allowed to settle, rallied through the stretch to be up for second. OUR MOMENT slow early, had a steady advance and finished well. WHAMO never far back, saved ground and went evenly. LIL GENERAL allowed to settle, failed to menace. SWEET WATER RIM dueled for the lead while between horses, tired in mid stretch. UNREAL OPTIMIST dueled for the lead until the eight pole, then weakened. R AND R EXPRESS vied for the lead, then tired through the lane. LET'S PARTY had brief foot, then dropped back.
