Footnotes

TREVI FOUNTAIN prompted the pace in the three path while patiently handled, responded to make the lead in deep stretch and won under strong handling. EAST END HOUSEWIFE always within striking distance, closed in the five path late and just missed. OPTIMISTIC BULLET (BRZ) set the pace until deep stretch then was outfinished. SPIRITUAL TUNE was leaning on the side of the gate at the start, broke a step slow then bore in and failed to menace. STYLISH DEPUTY was a sharp threat until mid stretch then weakened. BLACK SABLE failed to reach contention. TILLIE THE HUNN had brief speed. D'WILD DAY offered little.
