OFFICER MOO LA MOO was well placed early, rallied down the backside, shook clear on the second turn, remained well clear in the stretch under firm handling. ROBYNS AFAIRE was unhurried early, rallied through the stretch, finished well and was second best. PEAT BAY had good position throughout, lacked a late response and went evenly late. CARTER ROAD pressed the pace for three quarters, weakened in the stretch. OUR CONCERTO never far back and saved ground, angled out in the stretch and was no threat. BLITZ ECLIPSE raced mid pack, lacked a late response. BAJHEERA vied for the lead on the inside, gave way on the second turn. LITTLE SHNUCK raced wide throughout and was never in contention. LATEST IMPULSE allowed to settle, failed to menace. NANA'S PRINCESS flashed brief foot and was through early. SUNNY SIGHTS was outrun.
