### Footnotes

BELL'S PRINCE bore out causing a jam up at the break, was straightened and rushed up to command, set the pace inside, exchanged bumps leaving the three eighths pole, edged clear around the final turn, drifted out despite right handed pressure in mid stretch bothering HONG KONG HARRY then prevailed under a drive. HONG KONG HARRY prompted the pace three wide, exchanged bumps past the three furlong marker, came back to challenge the winner inside the eighth pole, was brushed and floated out with a sixteenth to go and stayed on well. GRAND SCIP stalked the pace three to four wide, shifted in late and closed the gap. NO CONFLICT saved ground, steadied making a run nearing the eighth pole, angled out then back in and hung late. FALCONHURST saved ground well off the pace, commenced a run leaving the far turn, swung out five wide and had belated action. AUSTIN BROWN , bumped and in close at the break, was sent up between rivals around the first turn, advanced five wide past the three eighths pole, chased and faded. HIGH GROSS prompted the pace, was bumped when between rivals leaving the three furlong marker, continued a forward presence to upper stretch then gave way. RICHIE THE THIEF , bumped and pinched back at the break, was not a threat. GRINNIN N WYNNIN , well wide, was not a threat. Following a stewards inquiry and objection by the rider of HONG KONG HARRY, BELL'S PRINCE was disqualified from first and placed second for causing interference in the stretch
