Footnotes

AWESOMESUNDAYBLUES saved ground under some early rating, edged closer near the three eighths pole, angled out into the far turn, came under a strong ride past the quarter pole, angled four wide for the drive, closed determinedly under pressure and got up at the wire. OUR JAKS rated three wide off the early duel, moved quickly to put a head in front nearing the far turn, dueled, was briefly headed nearing the eighth pole, battled back to regain command soon after, edged away a bit inside the sixteenth marker, finished gamely but just could not withstand the winner. GROSSO dueled inside for a half mile, dropped back some around the final turn, angled out and came again willingly. EMPRESS LISA dueled two wide through the opening half mile, dropped to the rail while dueling around the final turn, held a short lead into the lane then faded. PATCH OF FIRE, three to four wide, lacked a rally when called upon. SATIN ROSE saved ground stalking the early pace, shifted out in the drive and came up empty. TROPICAL RIDGE was outrun.
