Footnotes

BET THE CAT drafted to the rail early and stalked a contested pace, edged up under a ride leaving the three eighths pole, gave hard chase past the three sixteenths pole, swung out three wide into the lane, closed under strong handling while on his left lead and drew clear late. SMART SEQUOYAH prompted the pace two wide, moved to challenge in upper stretch and kept on gamely. CLAWER lagged well back early, angled four wide for the drive and rallied. DANCING FOR LOIS set a pressured pace inside, move clear after six furlongs, maintained a daylight advantage into the stretch, was collared nearing the sixteenth pole and weakened. SEATTLE SALUTE chased the pace three wide between rivals and faded. HIGH FLYING ROLLER rated back between rivals early, stalked the pace off the rail and gave way after six furlongs. KODIAK SONG was used four wide around the first turn and into the stretch the first time, moved to challenge five furlongs out, pressed past the half mile marker then weakened.
