TALK SHOW MAN was steadied back from between rivals near the seven eighths pole, angled in and stalked the pace, appeared to want to go inside in early backstretch but was instead taken wide past the three eighths marker, leveled off to a nice stride into the far turn, cruised past PETIE'S BOY entering the stretch, briefly wanted to get in near the sixteenth marker, was soon corrected and pulled away under hand urging. PETIE'S BOY cleared early, set a slow pace along the inside, was collared past the three sixteenths marker, kept on willingly but no match late. REBEL EXCHANGE stalked the pace three wide, was under pressure trying to keep up near the quarter pole, failed to sustain and faded. DUNE DANCER stalked the pace two wide and tired after six furlongs. JUST A CAT DANCING dropped back after a half mile.
