MORE MAYHEM accelerated to the early lead, set the pace along the rail and held sway under energetic urging. TEA TOT saved ground stalking the pace and rallied. THE PACK IS BACK lacked speed, saved ground and rallied. MR. CONDUCTOR chased the pace outside horses and failed to rally. CLOSING MAN was not a factor. RADNOR ROAD , wide the final turn, was not a factor. FORTUNATELY BOLD was outrun. MINESTRIKE , no factor, saved ground the final turn. MEDIA SPEED chased the pace outside the winner and faltered. THE RED HAMMER , shuffled back leaving the starting gate, trailed.
