ROMAN'S TOUCH , shuffled back soon after the break, gained a two wide lead on the backstretch and was kept to his business to prevail. LOOSE N CAPABLE , steadied in close quarters soon after the break, was three wide the far turn and rallied. R J'S PROSPECT , swung four wide near the eighth pole, had a late rally. PLEASE SIR drifted in soon after the break, angled to the rail when making the lead approaching the first turn, set the pace along the rail and tired. CELESTIAL FIELDS , steadied on the heels of PLEASE SIR entering the first turn, chased the pace and weakened. ONLY BY INVITATION , two wide the far turn, was no factor. HESA BIG STAR saved ground and weakened. ROMANS REWARD , steadied in close quarters soon after the break, was three wide the first turn and four wide the far turn. HOUSE ARREST trailed. An objection by the rider of CELESTIAL FIELDS against PLEASE SIR for alleged interference approaching the first turn was not allowed.
