FIVE STEPS settled back off of a hotly contested pace, surged four wide to command nearing the lane, kicked clear near the sixteenth marker and held sway under a drive. CELTIC INNIS stalked the pace while saving ground, steadied nearing the far turn, advanced entering the stretch, split rivals leaving the sixteenth pole and finished strong. P. KERNEY stalked the pace, lodged a three wide bid to challenge mid way on the final turn then faded in the drive. GREAT SENECA set a pressured pace inside, dueled around the far turn, held well to upper stretch then faded. LIL MOON MAN rushed up four wide into the first turn, lodged a three wide bid to challenge down the backstretch, dueled leaving the far turn then weakened in upper stretch. POPPY'S PUNKIN pressed the pace two wide and faltered leaving the far turn.
