SMOOTHE LANDING saved ground setting the pace and pulled away under a brisk drive. JOY TRAIN chased the winner, dropped back entering the final turn, angled out approaching the stretch and gamely regained the place. GRANDILOQUENT lost ground on all the turns and flattened out. PRIME MISTRESS, no factor, saved ground the final turn. MISSY KIM stalked the pace, angled out near the half mile pole, had a nice middle move entering the far turn then gave way entering the stretch. ANDRA stumbled at the break, saved ground and was not a factor.
