CHANCY'S CAT chased the pace while off the rail, steadily advanced three wide into the lane, forged to command near the sixteenth pole, raced on her lead and steadily drew away while under steady hand pressure. BETH'S FRIEND chased the pace while inside early, angled out on the turn, came three wide for the drive and rallied between rivals to earn the place. LADY BOP , bumped down the backstretch, raced removed from the rail and rallied mildly. KLONDIKE LIZZIE set the early pace inside, steadied back into the turn, altered out some late and finished with interest. DUCKTIONARY pressed the early pace two wide, kicked away around the turn then tired in the final sixteenth. A ROSE FOR MILADY lacked speed, saved ground into the lane then steadied when blocked in deep stretch. SKIP TOO WIN lacked speed, raced wide around the turn and failed to menace. I'M ERICA , bumped early, raced four wide around the turn and gave way. NERVOUS NUT broke slowly and was outrun.
