VALAY BULLET broke sharply, set a fast pace along the inside, drew off the final turn and was kept to a drive. LATIFAH well placed, was roused the final turn and gained the place. SHASHOBEGON saved ground early, angled the final turn, moved between horses near the 3/16 pole and rallied mildly. MERENGUE was hustled along down the backstretch and lacked the needed bid. HILL TOP JENNIE pressed the pace outside the winner and weakened into the lane. GIM'E A HUG saved ground, angled out near the 3/8 pole, had a four wide move the far turn then weakened. FERGIE'S WITCH in tight at the start, failed to menace. LEAVE NO PRINTS never factored. SMELLY CAT bobbed at the start, lost ground while racing five wide down the backstretch, raced four wide the final turn, angled in and weakened. SAMDANYA flipped in the gate, bobbed at the start, raced wide, stopped, and was being eased through the stretch.
