Footnotes

LASTING JOY sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace, moved off the inside for the drive and lasted. MIMI'S WINE COOLER reserved off the inside, moved to contention between rivals on the second turn, angled to the rail for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. CHIACCHIERONE reserved four wide, stayed in that path on the second turn and lacked a late bid. MISS QUACKERJACK outrun early, rallied belatedly. ANNS VISION forwardly placed, raced three wide on the second turn and had no late bid. GOLD BALL closest to the pace in the two path, tired. IRISH VISION forwardly placed along the inside, faded. MS STERLING SILVER could not menace.
