SHE'S CHEROKEE closest to the pace off the inside, challenged before a half, took over after six furlongs and stayed clear under pressure. DEPUTY SAMMIE reserved for a half, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out for the drive and finished willingly to be second best. HATTA FLOWER forwardly placed off the inside, tired. BROADBRUSH BEAUTY reserved in the two path, angled out midway through the second turn but gave way in the stretch. PINE SHELTER forwardly placed three wide, tired. GENTLE GRACE set the pace inside, responded willingly when challenged before a half, held on well to the final quarter and faded. MISS TARO within striking distance, was in the four path on the second turn and faded. ELECTRIC SKY was no factor.
