BIRMAN was unhurried into stride, responded when put to pressure with three furlongs to run, reeled in the leaders five wide and steadily drew clear. SWOOPER contested the pace four wide, kept on well through a prolonged drive, was unable to resist the winner but dug in to hold the place. MEDAGLIA STRIKES was allowed to settle, came five wide and was just up to earn the show. BEARCAT DAVID made a middle move between rivals to vie for the lead, disputed the issue to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. PEACEPIPE HIGH moved with his stable mate three wide between horses, prompted the pace to the stretch and gave way. GOLD RAKER was forwardly placed off of the inside for six furlongs and flattened. AXEL SWAGGER failed to respond. REGISTRY passed the tiring ones. DINNER TRAIN saved ground to no avail. PAYING THE BILL was outrun. MAMBO'S BRIDGE opened clear to set the pace, was collared before going a half, stopped once headed and was distanced through the stretch.
