FUTURE PROMISE drifted in at the start, rushed to a forward position outside and challenged before a quarter, took over after a half and drew clear under steady urging. EYE CAN FLAT RUN close up from the start, saved ground on the turn and lodged a mild bid to be second best. PRINCESS FREEDOM close up early, steadied and angled out four wide with three furlongs to go, maintained position to the final furlong and tired. STORMY HOT vied for the lead off the inside and tired in the final furlong. AMBER BE GOOD within striking distance from the start, lacked a rally. THUNDERING MARIA never far back five wide, had nothing left late. ROJA'S HERO outrun early, raced seven wide with three furlongs to go and was no factor. SHE'S STUBBORN was no threat. TEXAS INTIMIDATOR six wide on the turn, could not menace.
