CRIMSON KATE tracked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew clear late under a steady drive. SHESADOZER set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and yielded late in the stretch drive. TOSCA'S KISS chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and lacked a late gain in the stretch run. OCEAN SURGE stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. CLASSIC EMILY trailed the field early, angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch. HOW ABOUT ALEXIS pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and was empty in the stretch. CARMEN CAMACHO was never a threat. LIBEL AND SLANDER was done early.
