Footnotes

BARAT set the pace off the inside, drew off after a mile when asked and was not menaced while under steady handling. AZIRULE pressed the early pace outside the winner, dropped back a bit before a half, moved out four wide on the second turn and finished willingly to be up for the place. OUT DRINKIN' outrun off the rail, made a good middle move in the two path but could not sustain the bid. MASTER ROCKET forwardly placed three wide, held on well for a mile and tired. FLYING WARRIOR prominent four wide, moved in a path for the second turn and gave way in the stretch. RAILROAD ROY prompted the early pace three wide, moved in a bit after a half but faded after six furlongs. C R'S DEPUTY outrun early, lost his action twice on the backstretch and was pulled up.
