Footnotes

SASSY KRISTINA settled in hand near the tail of the field, responded when put to pressure with three furlongs to run, reeled in the leaders circling five wide, struck the front near the furlong marker and quickly drew clear. MISS RERUN tracked the pace three deep, drew even after a half, opened clear with a quarter to run, was no match for the winner but continued on well to clearly prove second best. MISSCINI was unhurried into stride, made a late rally circling seven wide and was just up to earn the show. JULES CONCERTO set the pressured pace along the inside, weakened entering the stretch, drifted out through the drive and gave way. ALEXANDRITE RING broke a step slow, rushed to contention from between horses, but flattened out leaving the second turn and faded. ROYAL RHAPSODY was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and retreated. MADLY raced wide throughout and failed to threaten. GINGER SEA pressed the pace two wide for five furlongs and stopped.
