**Footnotes**

TWO SEAT PETE settled into stride off of the inside, came three wide to make his bid, split rivals with a furlong to run, finished with a surge and was up in the final strides. STORMY PASSAGE was allowed to settle, launched his rally circling six wide, finished well but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. BEYOND READY disputed the pace along the inside, shook clear entering the stretch, weakened slightly during the drive and grudgingly gave way. FREE DRINKS stalked the pace four wide, moved up to engage the leaders leaving the turn, but lacked the needed late response. OUR TWO pulled to contention off of the inside, was blocked entering the stretch, altered course to the outside and was making up some ground late. INDIGO SLEW was allowed to settle, circled six wide and improved position late. GETALONG broke through the gate, contended between rivals five wide to the final furlong and faded. HE'S NO PIKER was allowed to settle, angled out to make a belated gain but was never a factor. SKEWED pressed the pace between horses to the stretch and tired. DASH RENDAR passed the tiring ones. PRINCE WOODMAN failed to respond. HOLY ROMAN EMPIRE vied for the lead three wide for a half and dropped

out.
