### Footnotes

SCAMMER closest to the pace while off the inside, challenged on the turn and drew clear under steady urging. GILDED TWINE forwardly placed off the inside, lodged a mild bid for the place. PRINCESS AMANDA lost her footing at the start, sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside but tired in the final furlong. COLD AWAKENING within striking distance, raced in the three path on the turn and lacked a late bid. IRONIC LADY unhurried early off the inside, was no real threat. KERNITRE (GB) was outrun. SILK SAILS was no factor. PEACEFULL SAND within striking distance along the inside, faded.
