PLUMLAKE LADY rushed into contention along the rail before a quarter, checked then altered course four wide entering the turn, the rallied determinedly through the stretch and was along in time. CLEVER MAID broke alertly to set a pressured pace until deep stretch then could not handle the winner. THE WRONG FACE allowed to settle, moved up three wide late and finished with good coverage. REGAL CASE failed to reach a contending position. TEMPTATION LADY was not a threat. BREWING MISCHIEF was no factor. GALES OF NOVEMBER offered little. STORM CLOCK dueled for the early lead between horses, was a sharp factor until the furlong marker then weakened. TRULIPS was shuffled back between horses at the start then never involved. IN CHARM'S WAY battled for the early lead then stopped. BOSTON SYMPHONY was through early. SAN ZHOOS flashed speed then stopped.
