DANCING NANCIES vied for the early lead outside rivals, took over on the turn and stayed clear under steady urging. MIMICRY unhurried early, raced four wide on the turn and lodged a mild bid for the place. PATOOT'S SO RARE forced the pace from the inside, held well to midstretch and tired. CRUISE ACROSS close up early, raced three wide on the turn and gave way in the final furlong. IRISH LILLABY pressed the early pace between rivals, was in tight near the half mile marker then tired.
