TEMPORARY SAINT behind the leaders, advanced three wide on the second turn, was carried out a bit in upper stretch then proved narrowly best. TEMPLAR'S CUP outrun early, made a good middle move in the two path, angled out for the drive, was blocked in deep stretch when I'M WAITING FOR U drifted out, angled out and finished willingly late to be steadily getting to the winner. I'M WAITING FOR U within striking distance, advanced four wide, drifted out a bit entering the stretch, drifted out again near the sixteenth marker then held on gamely. SKIP THE DETAILS unhurried early, advanced four wide approaching the stretch, was carried out entering the stretch then weakened. SARATOGA'S MAGIC vied for the early lead four wide, angled in, raced near the rail when battling for the advantage on the second turn but tired in the final furlong. CHILE'S QUEST prompted the early pace in the three path, moved in a bit after a half, held on well to the stretch and gave way. PETION STATION alternated for the lead along the inside and tired. PIPA CALIENTE within striking distance early three wide, tired. PIANO BUCKS stumbled start, no menace. RAYS RULES was outrun. A FOUL CLAIM BY THE TRAINER OF I'M WAITING FOR U AGAINST THE RIDER OF THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
