### Footnotes

CAT IN THE TREE closest to the pace three wide, challenged midway through the turn and drew clear under steady urging. DORAN'S MIRACLE within striking distance off the inside, lacked the needed closing bid. JOYJOYJOY close up along the inside, dropped back a bit on the turn then lodged a mild late bid. KITTY KISSES stumbled at the start and was outrun early, raced five wide on the turn and was no real threat. HAYDEN VALLEY within striking distance four wide, tired. MISSING SEFA close up on the rail, challenged midway through the turn but gave way in the drive. BOSTON STORM sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside and stopped.
