FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, January 3, 2007 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. Monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs.

Non-winners of a Sweepstakes allowed, 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given to Stakes winners, then those horses that have accumulated the highest career earnings. In addition no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. CARNACKS CHOICE lost his footing at the start, recovered quick to be with the early pace, took back a bit with five furlongs to go, waited behind horses on the turn, challenged from the rail with a furlong to go and proved narrowly best. JOE GOT EVEN within striking distance from the start, moved closer four wide on the turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but missed. CAJUN MON reserved early, steadied behind rivals entering the turn, raced within easy striking distance thereafter but lacked a late bid. DANNY SEZ vied for the lead near the rail, came off the inside in the stretch and tired late. REVIVAL RIDGE forwardly placed, challenged three wide on the turn but tired in the drive. AMERICA'S BEST was outrun. CAMP COMMANDER forced the pace off the inside and faded.
