NEW YORK BOBBY settled in hand off of the inside, worked his way to the outside through the turn, came five wide, opened clear and widened through the drive. KUFFS was unhurried into stride, angled out and split rivals leaving the turn, loomed a danger five wide but was unable to reach the winner. HARMONIC MAN was allowed to settle, circled six wide and was along for the show. NATIVE SEEKER attended the pace along the inside, got through to make a mild bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. CALLINGTHEWEATHER set the pressured pace off of the inside to the stretch and weakened between horses. CADILLAC CITY vied for the lead four wide through the turn and tired. KENTUCKY PRESENT pressed the pace between horses for a half and dropped out. WAKES WEEK was allowed to settle five wide and failed to respond. TWOHOOTSANDAHOLLAR reared at the start and unseated his jockey. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the start, but following the review made no change to the order of finish.
