LOPAKA KEONI close up early five wide, challenged before a half, gained a short lead on the second turn and proved best while fully extended. CARR POOL set the pace off the inside, dropped back along the inside on the second turn then came again to miss. WHITESIDE MT. behind the leaders, made a good four wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. FRIENDLY PARTNER pressed the early pace four wide, moved in a path late on the second turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. PALM SPRINGS close up three wide, tired. WRITER'S CRAMP outspurred early, moved closer in the three path on the second turn but had nothing left in the drive. LEGIONAIRE reserved early, raced in the four path on the second turn and could not menace. BILL'S BABY HUEY was outrun.
