LADYFLICKERFLACKER stalked the pace in hand, assumed command five wide and drew away to score as the rider pleased. UNCHECKED SOUL settled saving ground, got through nearing the quarter pole, was no match for the winner but kept on well to clearly prove second best. SKIP TOO WIN was allowed to settle, came three wide and finished with a late rally to earn the show. BELLA NORTH chased the pace three wide for five furlongs and tired. MONA ZONE opened clear to set the pace, was collared between horses before going six furlongs and gave way readily once headed. MI VIERA was jostled at the start, unhurried into stride and was never a factor. SHARPSTONE showed little. FIRMLAND was fractious to load, pulled six wide for a half and stopped.
