FRIDAYNIGHTDELITE sprinted clear, set the pace and drew off under steady handling. ASSIPATTLE within striking distance off the inside, angled out for the drive and lodged a mild bid to be up for the place. STORMS OF YANJI closest to the pace, held on well to the stretch and tired. SIR SHAUN outbroke his rider, raced five wide on the turn and could not threaten. PALLASO forwardly placed along the inside, faded. T MINUS THREE was outrun six wide. WELL WHAT failed to menace along the inside. PHEASANT LANE never reached contention. DIXIE BAND MAN close up four wide, faded. DESERT BAY was outrun. BRESLAUER steadied at the start and was no factor.
