Footnotes

MONKS SISTER outrun early, launched her rally four wide on the turn and finished full of run to be up in time. INCOMMUNICADO sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside, drew off on the turn but was outfinished. DIAMOND AFFAIR forwardly placed three wide, lodged a mild late bid. SECRET OF FINE reserved early, raced four wide past the three furlong marker and finished willingly late. LAST BOAT EAST outrun early off the inside, found her best stride too late. CASUAL SUCCESS within striking distance off the inside, had little left in the drive. MISS NIKNAR close up early along the inside, gave way in the drive.
