Footnotes

TRACI GIRL set the pace off the inside, moved out well off the inside on the backstretch, came back in to the three path entering the second turn, increased her lead after five furlongs then stayed clear under steady urging. DANCE DANCE reserved early, moved to contention along the inside on the second turn but lacked a late bid. MIZ LANDY outrun early, made a good move along the inside after five furlongs but lodged only a mild late bid. LEIGH LAKE outrun early, made a good middle move, came out four wide leaving the second turn but had little left late. DEVIL'S DIP within striking distance, was in the two path on the second turn and went evenly the final furlong. MISS GOOSEBUMPS outrun early, found her best stride too late. PARACLETE close up along the inside, angled out late on the backstretch to be five wide entering the second turn then tired. RACING RUBY forwardly placed four wide, faded in the drive. JUST KISS ME QUICK never far back in the three path, stopped.
