Footnotes

THOMAS IS ROCKIN dueled along the inside, shook clear leaving the second turn, and held safely through the drive. CLEANSSED was allowed to settle, circled five wide to make his bid, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. GRACE'S DEVIL broke a step slow, moved into contention along the inside, angled out with a quarter to run, loomed a danger but failed to sustain the drive. ABOVE THE CURVE was allowed to settle, ranged up four wide but went evenly through the stretch. LEGOLAS passed only the tiring ones. BROKEN TANGO dueled for the lead two wide, but came up empty after six furlongs and retreated. SMOKIN FAST contended along the inside for a half and dropped out.
