Footnotes

A CALL FOR GERTIE bumped at the start, recovered quickly, set the pace along the inside, repulsed U GOT THE TOUCH in upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. U GOT THE TOUCH bumped and forced in at the start, recovered to be close up along the rail, angled out and made a run at the winner entering the stretch, could not stay with that one late but held on for the place. HUNTERS RAE within striking distance near the rail, lacked a late bid. STORMY TERMS bumped and carried into U GOT THE TOUCH at the start, recovered to race closest to the early pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. BOOM BABY outrun early, moved out five wide late on the turn and was no threat. PATRIOTIC FEVER drifted in at the start, was forwardly placed four wide and faded.
