GO LYDIA GO settled in hand, launched her bid five wide, reeled in the leaders with a furlong to run and edged clear late. CASSABLANCA (GB) attended the pace off of the inside, was bottled up leaving the turn, altered course to the outside to find room and was making up ground once clear. MAYBELLE SLEW was forwardly placed four wide, kept on fairly well through a prolonged drive and held the show. ANN'S APPROVAL made a middle move between horses to engage the leaders midway through the turn, but flattened out during the drive and gave way. YANKEE PLAYER broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride, came five wide to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. SAILORS PASTTIME contested the pace along the inside to the stretch and tired. KID SOUP was away alertly, vied for the lead between horses to the turn and dropped out. SILVER BRITCHES was outrun.
